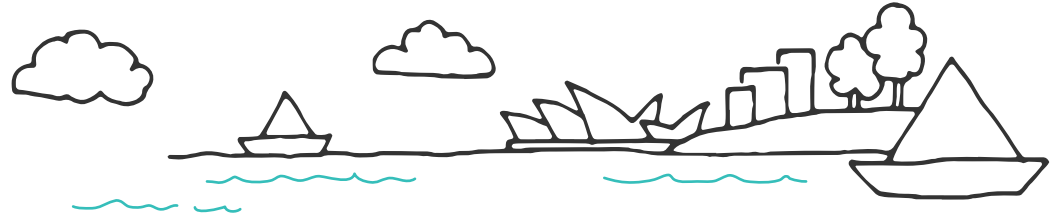
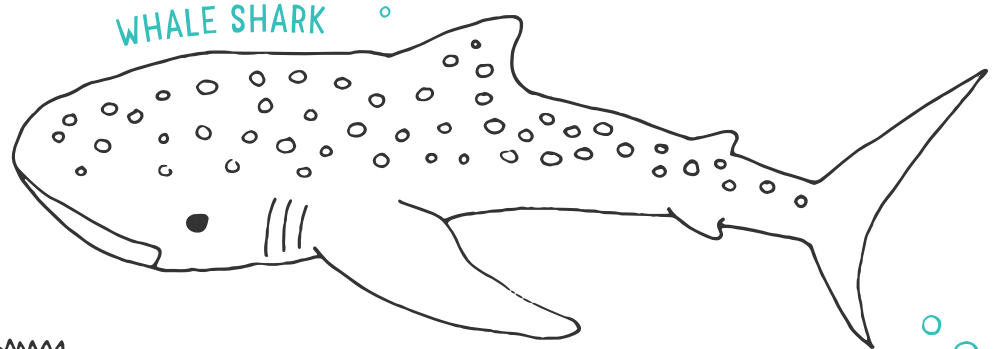


On land, the lion is king of beasts. But under the sea, sharks rule supreme!

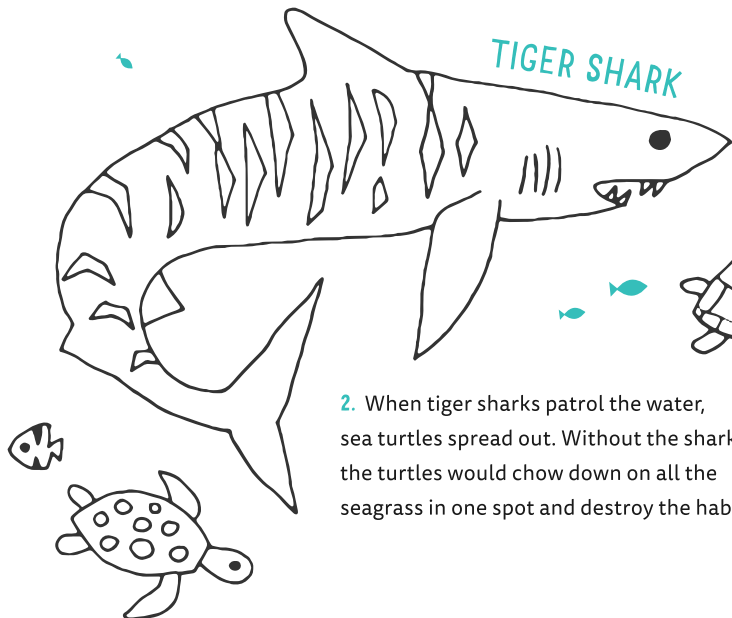
GREAT WHITE SHARK

More sharks = healthy fish = a healthy habitat.

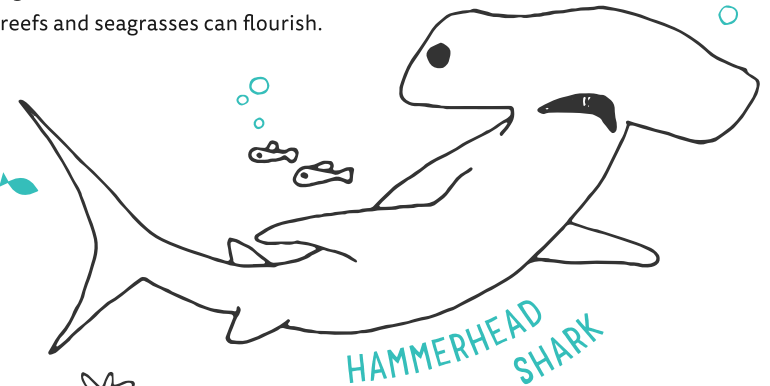
